

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority (Warren County (PR) MUA) for the fiscal year beginning, 1/1/13 and ending, 12/31/13 has been presented before the governing body of the Warren County (PR) MUA Authority at its open public meeting of October 17, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$2,719,778, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$2,719,778 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets utilized of \$0; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$8,252,500 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$0; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

The MUA increased appropriations \$64,721 (2.4%)\$ above the 2012 operating budget. The current rate of \$10.95/1,000 gallons represents no increase in sewer charges to system users for 2013.

A minimal rate increase will be necessary to maintain the authority's solvency.

The local economy appears to be stable and is slowly recovering from the severe recession. The proposed rate is unchanged from the prior year and the cost increase to the consumers will be minimal and will have little effect on the local economy.
